

CHAPTER 4

SPEED REGULATIONS

SECTION:

- 10-4-1: Basic Speed Limits
- 10-4-2: Violation of Speed Limits
- 10-4-3: Penalty

10-4-1: BASIC SPEED LIMITS: No person shall drive a motor vehicle upon any public highway in the Village at a speed greater than is reasonable and proper, having regard to the traffic and the use of the public way, or so as to endanger the life or limb or injure the property of any person. If the rate of speed of any motor vehicle operated on any public highway in the Village, excepting country roads and State highways, exceeds thirty (30) miles per hour, such rate of speed shall be prima facie evidence that the person operating such motor vehicle is running at a rate of speed greater than is reasonable and proper, having regard to the traffic and use of the way or so as to endanger the life or limb or injure the property of any person.

10-4-2: VIOLATION OF SPEED LIMITS: If the rate of speed of any motor vehicle operated on any country road or State highway in the Village exceeds the maximum speed limit fixed by county ordinance or State Statute, or as altered by the Department of Public Works and Buildings, Highway Division, such rates of speed shall be prima facie evidence that the person operating such vehicle is running at a rate of speed greater than is reasonable and proper, having regard to the traffic and use of the way or so as to endanger the life or limb and injure the property of any person.

10-4-3: PENALTY: Any person violating any provision of this Chapter shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.
